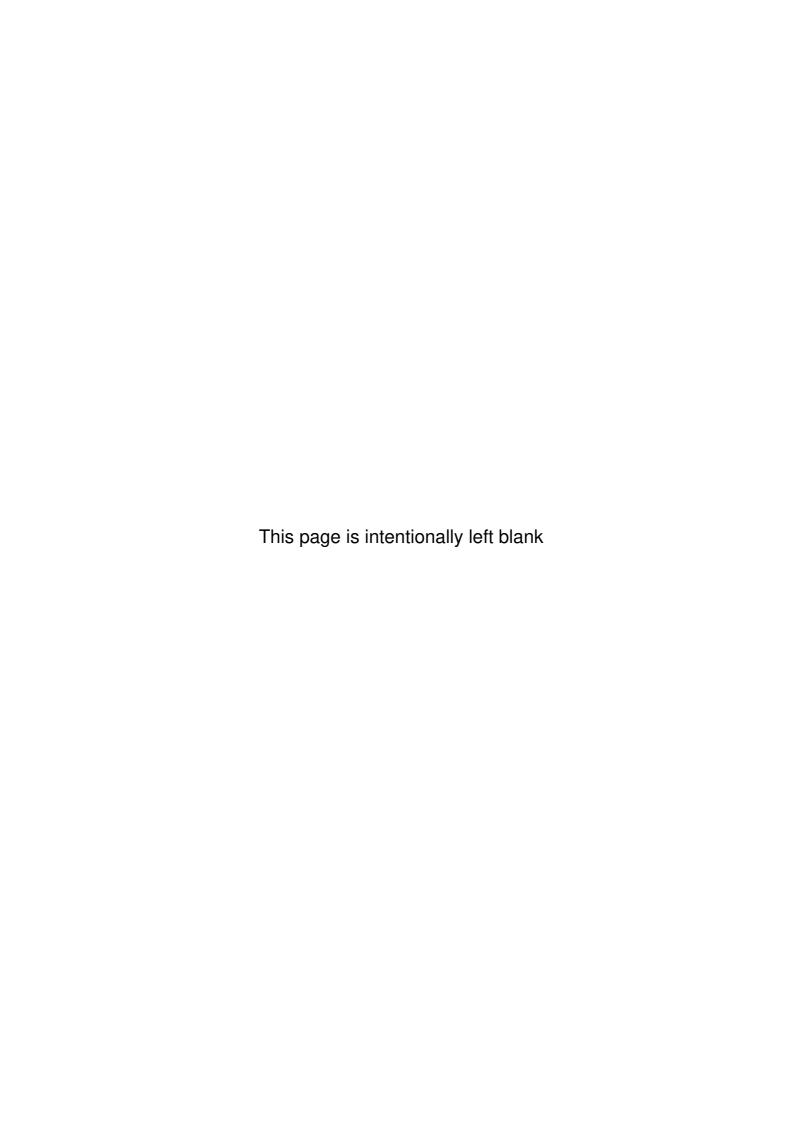

108/23 Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillor Rabey, who was substituted by Councillor A Westbrook.

109/23 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

110/23 Minutes

The minutes of 4 March 2024, having previously been circulated, were approved as a correct record and signed by Councillor J Westbrook.

111/23 Motion on Proms in the Park

Councillor J Westbrook spoke to the motion. She advised that the budget for the event was higher than the Community Development Committee budget and if the motion was agreed, it would have to be referred to Full Council for ratification.

It was proposed by Councillor J Westbrook, seconded by Councillor C Stokes and

UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to allocate £8000 taken from general reserves to deliver a live screening of BBC Last Night of the Proms in King George V Park on the evening of September 14th with officers having delegated authority to spend up to £8000 for all

provisions of the event, with feedback to the events working group monthly. Any additional funding requirements will be subject to review and discussion by the Community Development committee.

112/23 Motion for Music Event in KGV

Councillor J Westbrook spoke to the motion.

Councillor Griffin asked about lighting. The event was expected to start about 6:30pm so natural lighting and the festoon lighting should suffice.

Councillor Stokes asked about an Environmental Sound Report. The event was expected to end about 8:30pm so a report should not be necessary but near neighbours should be advised in advance.

Councillor Aves asked about drinks. There had been discussion of a bar and a decision on this was delegated to officers.

It was noted that the next Community Development Committee meeting was after the event and a special meeting would be needed if additional funding was required.

It was proposed by Councillor J Westbrook, second by Councillor A Griffin and

UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to allocate £1000 taken from the Community Development budget to deliver an evening of live music in King George V Park on the evening of June 21st with officers having delegated authority to spend up to £1000 for all provisions of the event. Additional funding requirements will be subject to review and discussion by the Community Development Committee.

113/23 A350 Underpass

Councillor Oatley advised that he had a meeting with Richard Rogers tomorrow (8th) and would report back. Councillor A Westbrook raised the issue of dilapidated fencing leading to the underpass and Councillor Griffin felt that the area generally needed a tidy up. Councillor Oatley agreed that he could explore the possibility of this being included in the scheme.

Councillor Griffin raised the possibility of leaving a section blank as a graffiti/street art area. It was felt that this was a good idea, but in a separate location.
