Temporary Closure of: Footpath 91, Melksham Without and Footpath 24, Melksham
(Ref: TTRO 10393)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all users:

A) **Footpath 91, Melksham Without**; from its junction with Bath Road to its junction with Footpath 24, Melksham.

B) **Footpath 24, Melksham**; from its junction with Footpath 91, Melksham Without to its junction with Shurnhold.

To enable: Wessex Water will be undertaking essential sewer network scheme in fields adjacent to Bath Road to alleviate flooding issues. The section of footpath will intersect a working easement area and will not be able to be kept open whilst the scheme takes place.

Alternative route: via A365 and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This closure which follows an emergency notice will come into operation on 26 May 2025 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 27 September 2025. Access will be maintained where possible although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 6 months.
