Proposed New 150mm Drain at St Georges Playing Field

Further to our meeting this morning we have pleasure in submitting our quotation for the new 150mm diameter drain in the sum of f14,628.00 plus VAT at the applicable rate.

Our quotation allows for excavating alongside the backdrop manhole on the edge of the park to invert and replacing the backdrop pipe with a 150mm plastic pipe.

Excavating and providing a new 150mm diameter pipe to an approximate depth of 1000mm from the backdrop to the existing manhole situated by the pavilion in two lengths to miss the existing delict building.

On the change of direction to provide a 450mm diameter manhole with a D400 manhole cover.

We have allowed for the whole run to be Heras fenced both sides of the excavation and for a standalone welfare unit.

Following our discussions and site visit I am submitting our quotation for your consideration.

I trust you find our quotation acceptable and look forward to receiving your instructions to proceed.

Description

New Foul drainage run from existing manhole near pavilion to existing Wessex Water chamber adjacent to road

- Mobilise plant and equipment to site
- Excavate adjacent to existing manhole with existing backdrop, connect stub and rocker pipes onto existing 100mm backdrop pipe at approx. 2.2 deep
- Take levels from invert levels of backdrop pipe and existing chamber adjacent to pavilion and work out gradient
- Set up pipe laser to new gradient level
- Excavate for and lay 100mm SN8 pipework at an average depth of 1.6 deep allowing for 75LM, air test all drainage runs and have witnessed by client
- Construct x 3 new manholes, concrete sectional, requirement of x 3 manholes are to avoid tree roots
- All trenches to be backfilled with as dug material
- Cart away surplus arrissings
- Place top soil to surface, rake and seed

We have allowed for 100mm drainage, if this has to be changed to 150mm pipe, the existing backdrop will have to be altered to suit, this would mean entering a manhole at 45m deep and fitting new backdrop system, this would add $\pm 6,500$ to above quote
